

TRIUMPH CHALLENGE **TRIPLE**

Fastest facts in under a lap of Brands Hatch Indy

Following the announcement of the Triumph Triple Challenge (TTC) featuring at nine British Superbike rounds again in 2012 we bring you all the key information you need to know in under 50 seconds about why the series is right for you.

Firstly, the cost, at just £15,999 inc vat for new entrants or £10,500 inc vat (Includes full engine refresh) for returning riders the series is ultracompetitive. The price includes a brand new stunning TTC liveried Triumph Daytona 675, yours to own and already kitted out with top of the range race accessories and includes your entry fees and full parts support from T3 Racing.

If £15,999 inc vat is a little hard to find in one go then dealer sponsored rides are available as well as a great payment plan to help ease the cash flow.

Secondly, the challenge is open to all ages, on track the championship will be split into two age groups; 16-27 and 28+ but all riders will be housed together in a striking new series awning. There is a fantastic reward for the 2011 TTC champion with progression to a full BSB support class ride or a brand new Daytona 675 should you be in the over 28 class, plus an amazing opportunity to compete in the final round of the British Superstock 600 for the highest ranked under 23 rider.

Thirdly, rider support and promotion. The championship prides itself on its academy scheme where riders will have access to information and tuition on all skills required to fulfil their potential, including fitness, race craft and bike setup with the added bonus of Frankie Chili coming along to selected rounds to help out. The series will reward all entrants and their sponsors with extensive TV coverage on British Eurosport, ability for bike branding, hospitality and public access to the riders and bikes within the TTC awning.

Finally and most importantly, TTC offers a great championship atmosphere with full support from T3, the series operator and the T3 race team including TTC championship winner Luke Jones and BSB Supersport cup winner John Simpson.
